



Pupils and Parents responsibilities

Pupil responsibilities

- To behave in an appropriate way projecting a good image of School at all times:
- To treat each other with respect.
- To raise any concerns with members of staff.
- Not to bring, buy or use illegal substances or any item prohibited by School.
- To refrain from consuming energy drinks or getting tattoos or piercings.
- To respect curfew and meeting times.
- Not to leave supervised groups or boundary areas.
- To work hard on and try out their Spanish, respecting instructions about use of mobile telephones, use of their own language in lessons at so on.

Parent responsibilities

To only call students in cases of emergency (after a previous conversation with their teacher). This ensures better assimilation and less home-sickness.

To allow teachers to deal with possible wobbles and complaints.

- To ensure that pupils are dropped off and collected from agreed points at agreed times.
- To ensure that pupils bring passports and GHIC cards.





- Please ensure that pupils have packed appropriate clothing.
- To ensure that School has been informed of any information pertinent to their son's or daughter's physical or mental health.
- To provide lunch or a snack for the day of travel to Spain (avoiding liquids as they will not be allowed on the plane).
- Allow around 10 Euros per day spending money.
